ARRIVAL PROCEDURES



PASSENGERS AND CREW ARRIVALS

A Universal Aviation staff member will meet the crew and passengers upon arrival. Passengers will be escorted to their ground transport vehicle after disembarking the aircraft. Ground transport drivers will pick up the crew and passengers a short walk from the aircraft outside the terminal.

The crew will coordinate final services and requests with our staff. If the aircraft remains overnight, the crew will be escorted to their ground transport vehicle upon completion of their final preparations.

It takes approximately 5-10 minutes from disembarking the aircraft to exiting the airport. We will keep in contact with your drivers to ensure you have a smooth pick-up.

DISABILITIES

Passengers with disabilities will have access to wheelchairs. Inform your Universal Aviation agent if you will require assistance for a passenger with a disability.

LUGGAGE

SUPERVISED VIA A UNIVERSAL STAFF MEMBER

Our staff will coordinate with the porters to transport all crew and passenger luggage from the aircraft to the passenger's ground transport vehicles.

PARKING

PROVIDED BY THE A/P MANAGER

Aircraft parking is available but limited. Upon arrival, the Paros tower will assist with the parking. A marshaller will be available on the spot to guide the aircraft. Request parking in advance during high travel seasons.

PET ARRIVALS

PERMITTED

A current International Veterinary Certificate/PET passport issued or endorsed by an Official Veterinarian from the country's Veterinary Authority is required. Pets must be microchipped or tattooed, and the NBR must be stated on the passport.

DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

PASSENGER AND CREW DEPARTURES

Passengers and crew should meet at the terminal entrance. A Universal Aviation staff member will be waiting to greet and assist everyone with their luggage. Once everyone has arrived, passengers and crew will be assisted through security before boarding the aircraft.

LUGGAGE

SUPERVISED BY A UNIVERSAL STAFF MEMBER

A Universal Aviation staff member will coordinate with porters to transport passengers and crew members' luggage. The porters will transport the luggage from passengers and crew members ground transport vehicles through security and finally load them into the aircraft.
